1. DROP OF AND PICK-UP

The learners that have siblings in school will all be picked up at the youngest child's pick-up point.

Parents are to please inform the transport drivers of the times and the drop-off and pick-up zones. All children making use of public transport will be picked up from the main carpark.

Contact time begins at 7: 30 all learners need to be at school latest by 7: 20 for scanning and screening and registration to take place. We would like to appeal to parents to please adhere to the starting times, so that we begin teaching on time without disruptions.

Parents please ensure that children are picked up on time and not left to their own devices in the carpark. This is for their own safety.
